

- yield** [jɪld] (n.) 讓位

- detour** [dɪ'tʊər] (n.) 纔道

- crosswalk** [kroʊs'wɔ:k] (n.) 行人穿越道

- pilot** ['paɪlot] (n.) 領航員：駕駛員

- cruise** [kru:z] (n.) 航
